A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

Consequences of Driving While Intoxicated

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 4-H YOUTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 1: All persons who receive a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) will automatically have their driver's license revoked for six months. All persons receiving a second DWI conviction will serve a sentence of 90 days in jail.

Section 2: The County Justice of the Peace shall enforce this law.

Section 3: All laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed. This act shall become effective upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law.
