The letter should not be from a relative of the applicant.

Tentatively set for the week of April 22: Candidate interviews (via 700m) with selection committee

- Tentatively set for the week of May 13: Announcement of candidates; Official candidate photos and short individual statements will be posted to Texas 4-H social media sites
- Monday, June 3: Each candidate will present a speech and answer impromptu questions during the Monday, June 5th At-Large Presentation event at Texas 4-H Roundup. Voting will take place electronically during the week of Texas 4-H Roundup.
- June 3, 2024 June 5, 2024 at midnight: Voting will be conducted through an online platform (to-be determined) and will open and close at specific times. Any Senior level 4-H member will be eligible to vote, even if they do not attend Texas 4-H Roundup
- June 6, 2024: Election results announced Announcement of the 6 At-Large Texas 4-H Council member will be made Thursday, June 6th at the conclusion of the General Assembly. Candidates do not have to be present at the Assembly.

CAMPAIGNING GUIDELINES

- An official photo and statement will be released for each candidate through the Texas 4-H social media platforms.
- Candidate campaigning WILL NOT be used until AFTER the official information has been released through state 4-H office.
- Candidates, counties and other groups affiliated with the candidate may develop post promoting said candidate. These posts may be shared through individual or group social media platforms.
- Please tag @texas4h and @tx4hcouncil when making posts
- o Negative comments targeted at others will not be tolerated.
- Giveaways, flyers, handouts, posters, custom t-shirts and any other form of campaigning other than the above-mentioned social media method before and/or during Texas 4-H Roundup are not permissible.
- Violation of the above policies regarding positive social media use and restricted campaigning methods will result in the disqualification of the candidate from the election process. The selection committee and the Texas 4-H Program Leader will have the authority for making decisions regarding the above policies and the decision will be final.

Process for the At-Large Elections

- Late March: Complete and submit a written brief application through 4HConnect outlining leadership experience, letter of recommendation (from anyone who can attest to the applicant's leadership abilities) and a two-minute video in response to a question prompt. Video will be uploaded, and the link must be submitted through the application.
- Late April: Candidate interviews (via Zoom) with selection committee which includes current Texas 4-H Advisors and members of the current Texas 4-H Council
- Early May: Announcement of candidates before Texas 4-H Roundup registration closes; Official candidate
 photos and short individual statements will be posted to Texas 4-H social media sites; Candidates will be
 required to register for and attend Texas 4-H Roundup on Monday, June 5th
- Mid May: Social media information posted by the Texas 4-H Office which can be used for campaigning
- June: Each candidate will present a live speech and answer impromptu questions on the Monday evening of Texas 4-H Roundup before an audience which will also be live streamed.
- June: Voting will be conducted electronically through 4HOnline or another approved method of voting and will open and close at specific times.
- June: Election results announced during Texas 4-H Roundup final recognition assembly.

You are required to submit a two-minute video answering the following question.


"How do you ignite interest among non members to become involved in the 4-H program?"


You will need to upload your video to YouTube. You may set your video as unlisted (not private) to ensure privacy of your video which will allow only those with the link to view the upload. Please list the YouTube link to your video in the appropriate section in the 4HOnline application. Remember this should only be two- minutes maximum. The recording should ONLY be submitted via a YouTube link. You will need to check specifications for YouTube upload to reduce confusion after you film your video. This is a required component of the application. Please contact Jana Barrett if you have questions regarding this process.

This form does not need to be uploaded into 4HOnline.

1. Go to www.youtube.com. Click on "Create Account." If you already have a Gmail account, click on "Sign In" and proceed to Step 4.

2. Complete the information shown to set up your account. Then click on "I Accept."





3. Once you have completed the account set-up, you should be ready to upload. Click on "Upload." in top right corner of the page. Looks like a video camera with a + sign in the middle.
