Month 1	 Collection Drives For Schools Conduct a collection drive of school supplies (paper, pencils, pens, notebooks, etc.) and donate to students in need First Aid Kits Assemble first-aid kits and donate to local organizations (schools, churches, groups) or have the first-aid kits placed in community buildings. Make it a point to replenish the first aid kits on an annual basis.
Month 2	Trick Or Treat Donation "Trick or Treat" in your neighborhood for canned goods and toiletries. Donate the items to the local food bank or homeless shelter. Fire Prevention Week During Fire Prevention Week, work with the local fire department to collect smoke alarms and distribute to those in need.
Month 3	 Shelters And Shut-ins Help cook and/or serve a meal at the local homeless shelter. Assemble fruit baskets (along with homemade goodies) and give to shut-ins.
Month 4	 Nursing Home Visits Decorate a Christmas tree at a nursing home, hospital or homeless shelter. Make and give the residents Christmas cards. Sing Christmas carols to the residents. Coordinate a craft time for the residents.
Month 5	Children's Hospital And Recycling Collections Collect children's books and movies and donate them to a nearby Children's Hospital. Collect old phone books for recycling.
Month 6	 Pet Or Animal Activities If weather permits, host a dog walk in a local park. Coordinate a photo pet session, charging a minimal fee. Donate the proceeds to the local animal shelter. Conduct a collection of pet food, supplies and newspapers to donate to the local animal shelter.
Month 7	 Clothing Donations And Drives Have a Fashion Show of garments for a local organization (i.e. Lion's Club) or senior citizens group. Conduct a clothing drive and provide an informational program on recycling clothing items.
Month 8	Bicycle Rodeo, Awareness And Safety • Host a bicycle rodeo, offering various games and prizes. • Offer information and community awareness of bicycle safety. • Conduct bicycle safety inspections.
Month 9	Flag Etiquette In honor of Memorial Day, conduct a flag etiquette program. Local Clean Up Assist with a local park or cemetery clean up.
