

34th Annual Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Extravaganza—April 20-21, 2018

2018 Registration Details

This is a beginner’s match and a learning event only. First and Second year Shooters ONLY. Rules are adjusted to accommodate this being a beginner’s match. These rules are for Extravaganza only. Rules for any other specific match do not apply at this event.

The **34th Annual Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Extravaganza** will take place at the Texas 4-H Conference Center on Lake Brownwood (<http://texas4hcenter.tamu.edu/>). This is an event for beginner shooters to learn the processes of shooting competitively. Basic knowledge of firearm safety, range safety, event rules, and event format is required. No previous competitive participation is required. **The emphasis is on exploring new shooting activities and having fun.** Participants are encouraged to register for events that they have never shot competitively. Space and time limit the event to a maximum of 400 participants. Medals will be awarded to the top three placings per age division in each event.

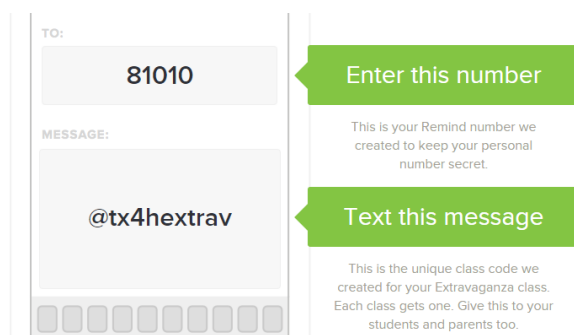

DO NOT MAIL - BRING WITH YOU ON APRIL 20 (or 21). • HAVE FUN! • A Target Scoring workshop will be held for any interested coaches, adults, and youth on Friday night, April 20th.
