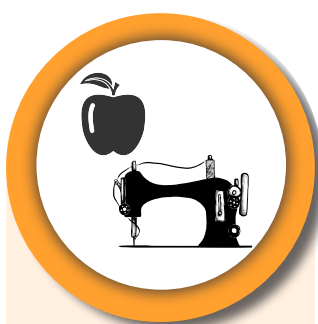
## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

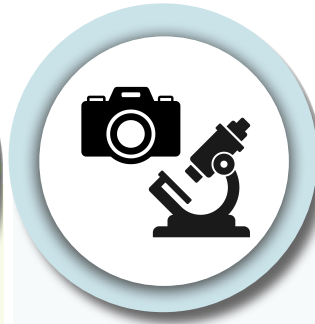
