Judge Recruitment Information

Any 4-H Dog project member, leader or County Extension Agent may recruit judges for the 2022 Texas 4-H Dog Show, July 8-9, 2022 in Conroe, Texas.

The process will be as follows:

- Members, leaders and County Extension Agents recruit potential Dog Show Judges who are experienced in the events we offer.
- Get a commitment from them that they are interested in judging. Submit completed recruitment form to Kristy Titzman, County Extension Agent - 4-H Youth Development, Walker County by April 8, 2022.
- Candidates will be evaluated and selected based on availability and skill level.
- Those selected will be contacted on or before May 31st for confirmation and those not selected will be contacted so they can release the date.
- As in the past the confirmed judges will not be announced until the program is distributed at the show.

Minimum Criteria:

- Provisional judge or current high level competitor in the events listed
- Available for the day of the contests they will be judging
- Not currently working with a 4-H State Show competitor (6 months from show)
- Willing to hold that date until they are contacted by May 31st
- Willing to provide contact and biographical information

This form will be submitted to Kristy Titzman by April 8, 2022. Selections and notifications will be made by May 31, 2022.

The 2022 Texas 4-H Dog Show will be held July 8-9, 2022 at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds in Conroe, Texas. We have an average of 100 handlers and 120 dogs. 4-H members are 8 to 18 years old with varying degrees of skill and quality of dogs, registered and mixed breed. Most of our classes are divided into three age divisions: 3rd - 5th grade are Juniors, 6th - 8th grade are Intermediate and 9th - 12th grade are Seniors. Lower skill level classes are larger than the higher skill levels. We are able to provide a \$50 stipend to each of our judges and will provide meals during the show as needed.
