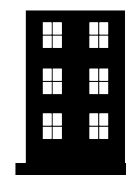
Adhere to Programs
for Minors policies.



No one to one
contact of adults
and youth.



Inform youth
and parents of
type of lodging
ahead of time.



Make room
assignments before
leaving & share with
parents & youth.



No youth should
be required to
sleep on the floor.



Make a contingency
plan for issues that
may arise on the trip.



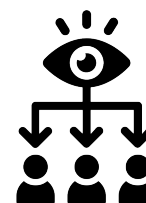
Adult with
non-family member
youth must have 3
people in the room.



Resolve parent and
participant concerns
prior to departure
when possible.



Supervise rooming,
discipline, curfew,
clean-up, etc.



There should be
at least one adult
representing each
gender of participants,
if possible.



Maintain
communication
with parents.



Room checks should
be conducted each
night making sure
youth are in assigned
rooms.



Adult to youth
ratio is 1:8



No youth and adult
may share a bed unless
they are family.



Meet at
designated time
and location for
departure.



At least two adults
21 or older should
chaperone.



Respect privacy of
youth when
changing clothes,
taking showers, etc.



Minimum
requirement is one
adult to two or more
youth members per
vehicle.
