

## **TEXAS 4-H CLUB/GROUP BYLAW REQUIREMENTS**

The name of the club must appear at the top of the bylaws and be worded the same on all other paperwork.

This shall be a nonprofit organization exclusively for the purpose of promoting 4-H Club work.

The objectives of this organization shall be:

- To provide learning situations for the development of leadership, responsibility, and effective citizenship.
- To provide educational and challenging experiences that will enable young people to become knowledgeable and skilled in their selected project areas.
- To provide information and training in other 4-H activities as members' interests dictate.
- To help each member experience personal growth and achievement, as well as be of service to others

members present, provided that the proposed amendments have been presented to the club in writing and filed with the secretary at the previous meeting of the club. Amendments must not conflict with the basic 4-H philosophy or the Texas 4-H Club/Group Charter Agreement.

These amendments are effective upon the affirmative vote of the members present.
