The contest is open to all youth in grades K-12. Participants must submit a completed entry form using the link below and an original illustration of a wild fish found in Texas. Participants in grades 4-12 must also submit a one-page creative writing piece.

Please note, Texas students may choose to enter national specialty awards with fish not found in Texas however because of the one entry per student limit they will not be eligible for Texas state awards.
