Texas 4-H Zsuites Record Book FAQs

POINT OF CLARIFICATION: You STILL need to print (or save as a PDF copy to submit online) your record book that is created through ZSuites for judging purposes. The method of submission (print or PDF) is determined by the county, District and State contest you may be submitting your record book to for review.

- 1. The paper format we have traditionally used, <u>IS STILL</u> an option for 2023-2024. We are currently evaluating the Texas 4-H Record Book process and changes may be announced for the 2024-2025 4-H year next Spring.
- 2. The ZSuites online system is **ANOTHER METHOD** for a 4-H member to use to report their 4-H involvement.
