Texas 4-H Zsuites Record Book FAQs

POINT OF CLARIFICATION : You STILL need to print and submit your record book that is created through ZSuites for judging purposes.

Updated 9/8/2020

- 1. The paper format we have traditionally used, **<u>IS STILL</u>** an option for 2020-2021.
- The ZSuites online system is <u>ANOTHER METHOD</u> for a 4-H member to use to report their 4-H involvement.
- 3. It may be possible that Record Book judging will be conducted similar to the 2020 process where a "disposable copy" of the Record Book will be submitted for State level judging through 4hOnline and the bound record books not be submitted for judging purposes.
