The **Backyard Bass** makes learning to cast fun! Simply place the Backyard Bass on the ground, stand away, and cast. Catch one of the Backyard Bass and reelitin, just like real fishing.



How to Use the Backyard Bass











SINGLE PLAYER GAME SUGGESTIONS

Place each Backyard Bass at different distances from where you plan to cast. See how long it takes you to reel all of them in. Assign points to the different Bass and see how many points you can accumulate as you cast. Reel and re-set the Bass.

TWO & THREE PLAYER GAME SUGGESTIONS

- 1. B-A-S-S: The Backyard Bass are placed around the yard and each player takes a turn trying to catch a fish. If he does the other player has to catch the same fish (from the same location) with one try. If the second player cannot catch that fish, he gets a letter (B). Players each take turns casting for fish, until one player has spelled the word "BASS" the player that has caught the most fish (the one with the least letters) wins.
- 2. Players assign point values to each fish. They then place the Backyard Bass in the yard and begin casting for the fish. The player with the most points wins.
- 3. Each player chooses a fish, and all of the Backyard Bass are placed at equal distances from where the players will cast. The first player to successfully catch and reel in their fish wins.
